Key Features of the Programme

- **What is it?**

It is the only qualification in the world which allows students to gain an MBA as well as Chartered Banker status

It is a unique and innovative dual accreditation from Bangor Business School and The Chartered Institute of Bankers in Scotland

It delivers practical and contemporary content to aid executives and managers to make sense of the holistic nature of bank management

It responds directly to the increasing global demand to develop and sustain responsible professionalism in global banking

- **How is it delivered?**

The degree is delivered by Blended learning. In practice this means that participants access their materials using Blackboard. The materials are accompanied by video clips, voiced PowerPoint presentations and other interactive materials.

- **How Long will it take me?**

The full degree can be completed in two years; those on the Accelerated route can complete in 18 months; and those on the Super Accelerated in 1 year.

- **And how much time each week will I need?**

It requires students to commit to around 15 - 20 hours a week of self study.

- **Can I do this full time?**

No, this is only available in Blended format; residential element in both London & Bangor Campus

- **Do I have to come to campus?**

Participants will spend 4 days each semester in London for revision sessions, examinations and sessions with Guest Speakers / visits to City Institutions.

- **What will I need?**

A reliable (preferably broadband) internet connection to enable you to participate in the online vide conference sessions together with a headset and microphone.

Who is it for?

- Senior individuals working in Banks or Financial Institutions who want to progress their careers.
- Professionals who want to move into the Banking sector

What are the entry requirements?

- A good first degree in a relevant subject and at least three years relevant managerial experience
OR
- An approved professional qualification and at least three years relevant managerial experience
- Exemptions for up to 50% of the programme are given to holders of professional banking qualifications
- Holders of recognised MBAs may qualify for the super accelerated programme.

What is the format?

For the full route, participants study 8 core and four electives; for the accelerated route students study 5 core and two electives. (module list shown overleaf). The Super Accelerate route is a set programme (shown overleaf)

How is it assessed?

Core modules are assessed by assignment and examination.

Electives are assessed by a 5,000 word research project, each of which applies the skills gained in the Research Methods module and which is essentially a "mini consultancy project"

Scholarships:

There are a limited number of scholarships available upon application.

When can I start?
