Job Description (Technical Expert)

The primary role of the Technical Expert is expected provide leadership and faculty support in the development of new curriculum content, innovate training methods, teaching support through research, dissemination and publication. The incumbent is expected to work at a broadly defined environment, sufficient to merit authorship on research publications, and should be able to assist across multi-disciplinary banking disciplines.

Scope

The Technical Expert will work and collaborate with industry experts and be able to produce, share new concepts and applications in learning opportunities as part of his or her contributions towards the development of new education and learning architectures of the institute. Part of the remit is to ensure engagement with the industry is to devote attention to teaching methodologies and leadership skills. The individual will also have the passions to drive global education standards

He or she will be expected to innovate new pedagogies and teaching methods of learning. The Technical Expert will also work closely with collaborators in research programs well as with existing and new partners towards the development of new course curriculum and programs. Key Roles:

- Investigate and conduct research on the developments in education standards and practice including the development of ethical curriculum and identifying broader issues based on requests/recommendations from stakeholders or through other means in the context of developments taking place in the industry
- Drive and manage the research activities that will shape future agenda of the development of banking profession involving multi-disciplinary research on changes in banking business disciplines and topics through close collaborations and partnership with members , universities, regulators and other key stakeholders
- Contribute to research so as to merit serving as author or co-author on research publications that includes:
 - Assist in the development of research contract proposals
 - Assists in manuscript preparation for banking journals.
 - Present research findings as needed
- Independently manage applied research projects through review and consultation and soliciting broad stakeholder inputs towards discussion drafts
- Supervise data collection and analyses for research project(s) requiring independent and timely interpretation and dissemination
- Exercise discretion and independent judgment to develop methods and procedures for operation of complex and multi disciplinary research
- Lead and co-ordinate with subject matter experts from industry and regulators with respect to competency requirements
- Develop, co-ordinate and identify professional standards on banking education and learning as part of setting industry education benchmarks
- Establish and develop banking standards and guidance for use by banking industry and professionals across their education and learning activities
- Provide a forum for premium conferences and seminars for discussion and dialogues on development curriculum standards, pedagogical and application tools, and ideas for the development of banking profession
- Develop mechanisms for providing channels of dissemination of information and updates to members and relevant stakeholders in the use of the standards for changes
- Participate and facilitate the exchange of information through the Global Banking Education Standard Board to ensure members are adequately informed, of any developments and changes or amendments to the current education standard

- Strengthen and play an active role in the publication and dissemination of high recommendations to strengthen national capacity
- Responsible for plan and coordination of literature and knowledge management and dissemination programs
 - Develop reports of results, graphs, charts, tables, etc. of research findings
